

Homemade Playdough Recipe:

I have used playdough in some of our recent science experiments. The students were asking for the recipe so here it is:

Mix together the following dry ingredients:

2 cups flour
1 cup salt
4 tablespoons cream of tartar

Mix together the following wet ingredients:

2 cups boiling water
2 tablespoons oil
Few drops food colouring

Add the wet items to the dry. Stir and knead until smooth.
